

# Missouri Farmers' Market Nutrition Program Farmer Requirements

## What is the program?

The Missouri Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (MoFMNP) provides funds to low-income Seniors and families who receive WIC benefits to purchase eligible foods from an authorized vendor at a farmers' market. Participating seniors receive \$50 in benefits and each individual in the WIC program receives \$20 in benefits.

## Important Dates:

- Benefits issued: May 1 - Sept. 30
- Benefits redeemed: May 1 - Oct. 31

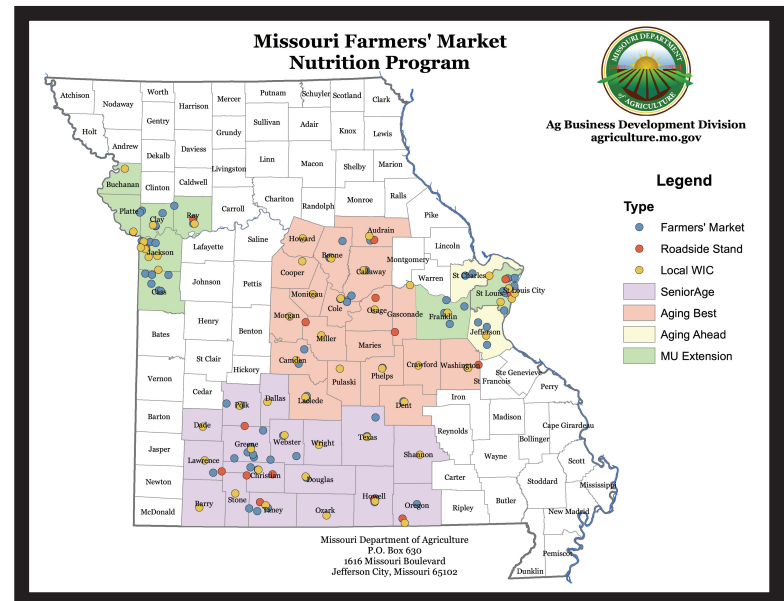
## To be authorized, farmers must:

- Live and grow in Missouri or Kansas and Illinois that borders Missouri.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Grow at least 50% of what you sell at the farmers' market.
- Sell eligible foods (fresh fruit, vegetables, herbs and honey).
- Attend annual training provided by the Missouri Department of Agriculture.
- Sell at a farmers' market or roadside stand in at least one of the listed counties.
- Have a smart device.
